FREE • EASY • ACCESSIBLE • ANONYMOUS

CA Notify is a free, easy to use, accessible, and privacy preserving exposure notification technology that can help stop the spread of COVID-19.

Exposure notifications help alert people if they've been exposed to COVID-19 so they can get tested, monitor their symptoms, and take the necessary precautions.

You can also notify others if you test positive, while remaining anonymous. Your personal information is never collected, so you and those around you can stay safe.

CA Notify detects exposures that traditional contact tracing interviews may not—such as random mixing events where exposed persons may not be personally known to the infected individual.

How it works:

- Add CA Notify to your phone.
- When in close contact with other CA Notify users, your phones share anonymous codes.
- If a user tests positive for COVID-19, they can notify others.
- You receive an exposure notification with instructions on what to do next.
- If you test positive, you may:
 - Provide information about your positive result using CA Notify or by calling toll-free 1 (888) 421-9457 to anonymously alert other you may have exposed.
 - Receive a text message from the California Department of Public Health with a link that you can click to report your result. Follow the instructions to the end to anonymously alert those you may have exposed.
- If fully vaccinated, you can monitor for symptoms.

CA Notify uses Bluetooth technology to estimate how close your phone is to others and for how long. The system does not use GPS, track your specific location, or tell you who exposed you.

Activation is simple.

iPhone users go to your settings, turn on Exposure Notifications, and select U.S. and California as their region. Android users download the app through the Google Play store and follow the prompts.
